

Jewellery Policy

In the interests of workers' safety, JBM Power prohibits workers, while at work, from wearing personal jewellery that is freely suspended from the body.

For example, the wearing of earrings, exposed body chains, bracelets, and necklaces (outside the shirt) are not permitted, where the jewellery has the potential of catching or becoming attached to items of plant, equipment, structure, appliances, or devices that may cause injury to that worker. In such instances, the worker must remove the jewellery prior to commencing work.

Some items of jewellery are acceptable such as: watches, finger rings, body piercing studs, sleepers, and items that are covered by clothing or other means.

The management of JBM Power reserves the right to instruct a worker to remove any jewellery that the management believes may cause injury to the worker.

This policy has been compiled in the interest of safety to the workers whilst at their place of work in accordance with the legislative requirements.
