

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Policy

JBM Power is committed to the provision of personal protective equipment to all JBM Power personnel as required by legislation. Personal protective equipment shall be issued to all employees where and when required, to ensure their safety whilst undertaking work related activities.

Personal protective equipment may include items such as, but not limited to; steel capped safety boots, long sleeved shirts, long trousers, safety helmets, eye protection, respirators, hearing protection, gloves and sun screen.

JBM Power shall supply additional personal protective equipment necessary to undertake work activities as and where required.

Upon issue of personal protective equipment to employees, the employees are required to sign for the equipment to verify that it has been issued. All personal protective equipment shall be stored appropriately to avoid damage to the PPE, ensuring that it remains fit for purpose.

It is always the responsibility of employees to care for and maintain personal protective equipment. If personal protective equipment is damaged, it is the responsibility of the employee to report it to their supervisor and present the damaged equipment for replacement.

Personal protective equipment issued, must be worn in accordance with JBM's requirements and in association with client site processes and procedures. Any breach in compliance with the use and wearing of personal protective equipment will result in disciplinary action.

Managers and Supervisors shall ensure that personal protective equipment is being worn and maintained in accordance with procedures.
